- 7. What is the difference between Exodus 4:31 and Exodus 5:20-21?
- 8. The people of Israel persistently complained against God's will and criticized His leaders. Why do you think these are so common sins among God's people?
- 9. What is a good response when we encounter opposition and misunderstanding, as Moses did?
- 10. Have you ever responded to God as Moses did in Exodus 5:22-23?
