- 7. Why should Christians be the most joyous people in the world? How does the Christian inexpressible joy transcend other versions of joy we may experience in the world?
- 8. What is salvation the outcome of our faith (1 Peter 3:9)? If we are able to put our faith in eternal salvation, how should this influence our ability to put faith in
- 9. Jesus, the author and King of joy, is the one who gives us the joy that we express. If you would not define your life as joyous, how can we pray for you?
