- 4. What does Peter say about fear? Why?
- 5. There is a difference between suffering and suffering for righteousness's sake. How do you distinguish the two?
- 6. Have you ever suffered for righteousness's sake? Would you describe the end result as blessed? Why or why not?
- 7. How do you "in your hearts honor Christ the Lord as holy" (1 Peter 3:15)? What aspects of your life reflect this?
- 8. Do you feel that you are "always prepared to make a defense to anyone who asks you for a reason for the hope that is in you" (1 Peter 3:15)? Are there any barriers that hinder you from doing so?
- 9. One distinction of the Christian witness is to "do it with gentleness and respect" (1 Peter 3:15). How does this define your testimony (story) and witness (how you live)?
- 10. How does a good conscience help a believer in times of trial and opposition?
