1. What has framed your understanding of “how things should be”? What has most influenced your current perspective?
2. Marriage has a variety of different perspectives throughout the world. Do you think the Bible’s framework for marriage is universally applicable?
3. Is marriage a spiritual or physical union? Explain.
4. What is the only scriptural basis for divorce? Why?
5. What is the Christian alternative to divorce for whatever reason?
6. Why do you think there are so many more divorces today than there were forty or fifty years ago? How has divorce impacted the church?
7. What was the Corinthians’ rationale for sexual freedom (1 Corinthians 6:12-20)? How does this rationalization compare to modern-day attitudes toward sexuality?
8. 1 Corinthians 7:1-16 addresses many principles for marriage. How should we address marriage difficulties that are not addressed within this passage (or Scripture as a whole)?
9. What do you think is the best way to keep a marriage whole and happy?
10. Paul encourages the Corinthians not to disassociate themselves from people outside the church (1 Corinthians 5:9-13). How do these verses reframe our engagement with the world?
