- 1. How have you heard Satan described? How have you described Satan? What has influenced your perception and description?
- 2. As C.S. Lewis stated, we are prone to two equal and opposite errors. One is to disbelieve the existence of Satan, the other is to feel an excessive and unhealthy interest in them. If you were inclined in one direction, which would it be?
- 3. What is so crucial about the third chapter of Genesis?
- 4. How convinced of or aware are you of Satan's influence on your daily life? Why is that?
- 5. In what disguises might we find Satan today?
- 6. Have you ever found yourself, like Eve, doubting God's Word? Why do you think that doubt creeps in?
- 7. What is the overarching lie that humans have believed since the fall? Why is this lie so fundamental? [Leader's Note: "Did God actually say...?" (Genesis 3:1)]
- 8. Why is it important to remember the beginning (Genesis 3) and the end (Revelation 20) as we discuss Satan? How does this influence how we live our lives in between?
- 9. As you consider the battle between God and Satan/good and evil, have you ever thought of it as more of a battle than the Bible describes? Explain.
- 10. If deception is the only tactic of Satan, how can we guard against deception?
- 11. The first half of Revelation 12:11 is quoted often, "And they conquered him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony." Was is the second half of this verse equally as important?
