1. How easy is it for you to believe in things that can't be seen, heard, or sensed in some other physical way? Why is that?
2. According to John, a satisfying reality can be found not in things or thrills, but in a Person (1 John 1:1-4). Why is Jesus Christ more real than things or thrills?
3. Why can't the created world alone reveal God's love to us?
4. How does creation reveal God's existence? His power? His wisdom?
5. Why is Jesus called "the Word of Life? (1 John 1:1)"
6. Why was the Word made flesh (John 1:14-18)?
7. God's Word carries absolute authority. "For he spoke, and it came to be; he commanded, and it stood firm" (Psalm 33:9). How does this affect your relationship with God?
8. At creation, God spoke powerful words (Genesis 1-2). What powerful words has God spoken on your behalf?
9. When God created, He said, "Let there be light" and it was so (Genesis 1:3). God separated the light from the darkness (Genesis 1:4). Do you believe God has the same power over darkness today?
10. Are there any places where God is bringing light to your life or casting out darkness? How can we continue to pray for God to do so?
11. Have you ever felt that one of the purposes of God is, "so that our joy may be complete" (1 John 1:4)? How have you found this to be true in your life?
