

**Sermon Title**: Light in the Dark: The True Light

Scripture: 1 John 2:7-14; Mark 12:28-34

- 1. On Sunday, Harbor Trinity Church celebrated 70 years (1955-2025). What has been your favorite memory at Harbor Trinity thus far? What are you hopeful/prayerful/expectant to experience in the future?
- 2. Have you ever considered the Theological Test (1 John 1:5-2:2), Moral Test (1 John 2:3-6), and Ethical Test (1 John 2:7-11) as a framework that "we may know that we are in him" (1 John 2:5)? How is this helpful to you understanding your faith?
- 3. Jesus summarized "all the Law and the Prophets" (Matthew 22:40) in his response to a scribe in Mark 12:38-34. Do you find Jesus' response to the Bible to be adequate? Why or why not?
- 4. How is loving one another a "new commandment" through Jesus Christ? How does "just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another" (John 13:34) differ from "love your neighbor as yourself" (Mark 12:31)?
- 5. As we consider the implication of these commandments, what is your definition of true Christian love? Why do you define it in this way?
- 6. What were some practical ways Jesus demonstrated His love while on earth?
- 7. How have you demonstrated this love to others?
- 8. John provides a stark contrast in the implications of our love for one another in 1 John 2:9-11. Are there implications or applications that come to mind for you?
- 9. How would you describe yourself according to John 2:12-14? Would you be a little child, young person, or adult?
- 10. Justin mentioned that one of the defining characteristics of a father is someone who reproduces. The same is true for disciples. If you would consider yourself a spiritual father/mother, who have you reproduced spiritually to walk like Jesus? Who are you continuing this process with?
- 11. Before we conclude, let's take a moment to pray for one another and for the next 70 years at Harbor Trinity. May God continue to build His Church, just as He has promised.
