**Sermon Title:** I Am: The Light of the World

**Scripture:** John 8:12-30

1. Do you struggle to know where you are going? Does life ever feel like walking in darkness?
2. Let's read John 8:12-20. How do you respond to Jesus' promise in John 8:12?
3. What did Jesus mean when He said, "I am the light of the world?"
4. What was Jesus' main point in this argument with the Pharisees?
5. Whether we like it or not, we all judge. Jesus said, "Yet even if I do judge, my judgment is true" (John 8:16). Is there a place that is particularly difficult for you not to judge someone in? How can our understanding of Jesus' view of judgment help us?
6. Let's read John 8:21-30. What claims to deity did Jesus make?
7. Why does it matter that Jesus claimed to be God?
8. Why do many people find this claim so offensive?
9. Jesus' claims in this passage (and those to come) are nothing new. As Jesus said, "I have been telling you from the beginning" (John 8:25). Why is Jesus' consistency in His claims important?
10. Despite the response of some, "many believed in him" (John 8:30). We are never responsible for someone's response, but we are responsible for how we proclaim. How can you share about who Jesus is this week? Do you have someone in mind you can share with?
11. As we conclude our time, let's take a moment to pray with and for one another. Jesus would say of His disciples, "You are the light of the world" (Matthew 5:14). May we live our lives accordingly this week.
