Sermon Title: I Am: The Door

Scripture: John 10:1-10

Date: February 22nd, 2026

1. Who are some people you have “followed” in the past?
2. Are there criteria you use for whether you follow a person, listen to their voice, or allow their influence?
3. Read John 10:1-6. Who or what is Jesus describing during these verses? Why do you think the people “did not understand what he was saying to them” (John 10:6)?
4. Who would Jesus call thieves today? Why?
5. Are there other Christians who hold a different theological/denominational/political/sociological perspective that would refer to people you follow as thieves? Does Jesus’ warning transcend culture or is it limited in its application?
6. Read John 10:7-10. How does Jesus describe Himself in these verses?
7. We expect Jesus to say He is the shepherd (stay tuned for next week). Why does Jesus say, “I am the door of the sheep” (John 10:7)?
8. How is Jesus like a door into the sheepfold? How have you experienced Jesus as a door like this?
9. We would expect that a thief would come to steal, but Jesus amplifies the impact of the thief as one who kills and destroys (John 10:10). How have you seen this be true?
10. What does “abundant life” (John 10:10) mean? Are you currently experiencing it? Why or why not?
11. As we answer the abundant life question, we must also ask if our answer would be equally applicable to other parts of the world and other times in history. If it is only applicable to modern Orange County or America, it is not what Jesus had in mind. How does this statement make you feel?
