## *Discussion Questions*

**Sermon Title:** I Am: The True Vine

**Scripture:** John 15:1-17

**Date:** March 22nd, 2026

1. Have you ever had a plant or tree that died or did not produce fruit? How did you respond?
2. Let's read John 15:1-17. What is significant about Jesus' use of the vine and branches to teach about our relationship with Him?
3. Based on how you responded to your plant/tree, how does this help you understand how God responds to us?
4. Is there anything a plant can do to make itself grow more? How does this help us as we consider our growth?
5. What does (or should) abiding in Christ involve for you—practically speaking, on a typical day?
6. When is it hard for you to abide in Jesus? Why?
7. How does God prune us? Why?
8. When have you experienced God pruning you? How did you respond?
9. What fruit does God want us to produce? How do we do that?
10. Consider the significance of the statement, "You did not choose me, but I chose you" (John 15:16). What does it mean that you are chosen by God?
11. As our series through the "I Am..." statements within the Gospel of John comes to a close, is there a particular week or statement that was most impactful to you. If so, which one was it and why?
12. Eggstravaganza (Sunday, March 29th), Good Friday (March 3rd), and Easter Sunday (April 5th) are fast approaching. Are there family, friends, coworkers, and neighbors you are planning to have join us (everyone should have someone)? Can we commit to pray for each of them by name in the days to come?
