1. Are there things that you would consider yourself uniquely good/great at? Is this something that has been true for the majority of your life, something that has been developed, or a combination of both?
2. This weekend, we were able to introduce a new series of assessments and spiritual gifts tests? Were you able to take the test? If so, what were the results?
3. The passages listed above each demonstrate how the Holy Spirit provides and empowers spiritual gifts. What are the uniquenesses of each passage? How do the passages together demonstrate unity?
4. 1 Corinthians 12 is the most commonly referred to passage on spiritual gifts. What do we learn as we read Exodus 35-36 as well? Have you ever considered craftsmanship or artisanship as spiritual giftings?
5. What is God's purpose in giving Christians spiritual gifts (1 Corinthians 12:7)?
6. If God is the one who gives the gifts, how should we think of ourselves (Romans 12:3)? How should we think of others (Romans 12:4-5)?
7. Why do we sometimes avoid working with certain people in the church? According to 1 Corinthians 12:1-3, what reasons do we have to work together?
8. How have you seen people using their spiritual gifts at Harbor Trinity (or beyond)? Please reference Exodus 35:31-35, 1 Corinthians 12:8-10, and Romans 12:6-8 for the specific lists within each passage?
9. How does the human body demonstrate diversity? What kind of diversity is there among this group? Harbor Trinity at large?
10. How can we keep our diversity from becoming disunity?
11. How are you currently using your gifts to "raise up mature disciples who intentionally help people find and follow Jesus"? Are there any ways that God is inviting you to step up or step in with your gifts?
